



Situate in Patton township Centre County (formerly Cumberland) containing three hundred and ten acres and one hundred and twenty six perches and allowance of six per cent (being part of a tract of land surveyed for Matthias Johns the 3rd day of November 1766 in pursuance of an order N^o 412 dated the 1st day of August 1766) divided as above the 10th day of December A.D. 1828.
