



The above is a Draught of a Survey made Feby 6th 1828 for Balford Doherty in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him, dated January 16th 1828 for one Acre of land, but Contains Eleven Acres and forty two perches and allowance of six pr Cent for highways Situate in Fallowfield Township W.C., on the above land there is no improvement, Henry Speers had fenced in a small piece of Bottom (about 3/4 of an acre) but never improved it
