



The above is a Draught of a Survey made December 2<sup>d</sup> 1828, for Parker Scott Esq agent for Joshua Dunkan situate in Pike Run Township W. Co. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Dwyer Dated March 10<sup>th</sup> 1797 for two hundred acres of land but Contains only one hundred and thirteen Acres and 97 perches and allowance of six per cent. for highways. The above embraces the whole tract, Dwyer thought to get about 90 acres more on the side next Bailey and Risinger but it was covered by an older title the adjoining lands are all Patented an<sup>d</sup> the lines marked before this survey.
