



Situate on the west side of French Creek in Allegheny County containing 401 Acres 150 P's and allowance of six p' Cent for Roads &c Resurveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> May 1799 In pursuance of a warrant of 400 Acres granted to James Duncan bearing date 30<sup>th</sup> May 1792 It being the same tract of land which was surveyed 2<sup>nd</sup> June 1795 for John Stewart & on his improvement dated 15<sup>th</sup> May 1795
