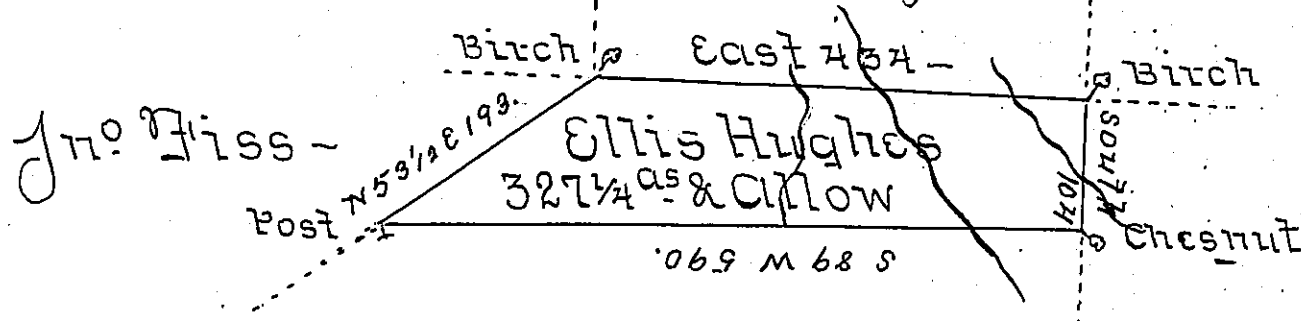

Containing Three Hundred & Twenty Seven Acres & one Quarter with the Allowance of six Per Cent for Roads &c ~
