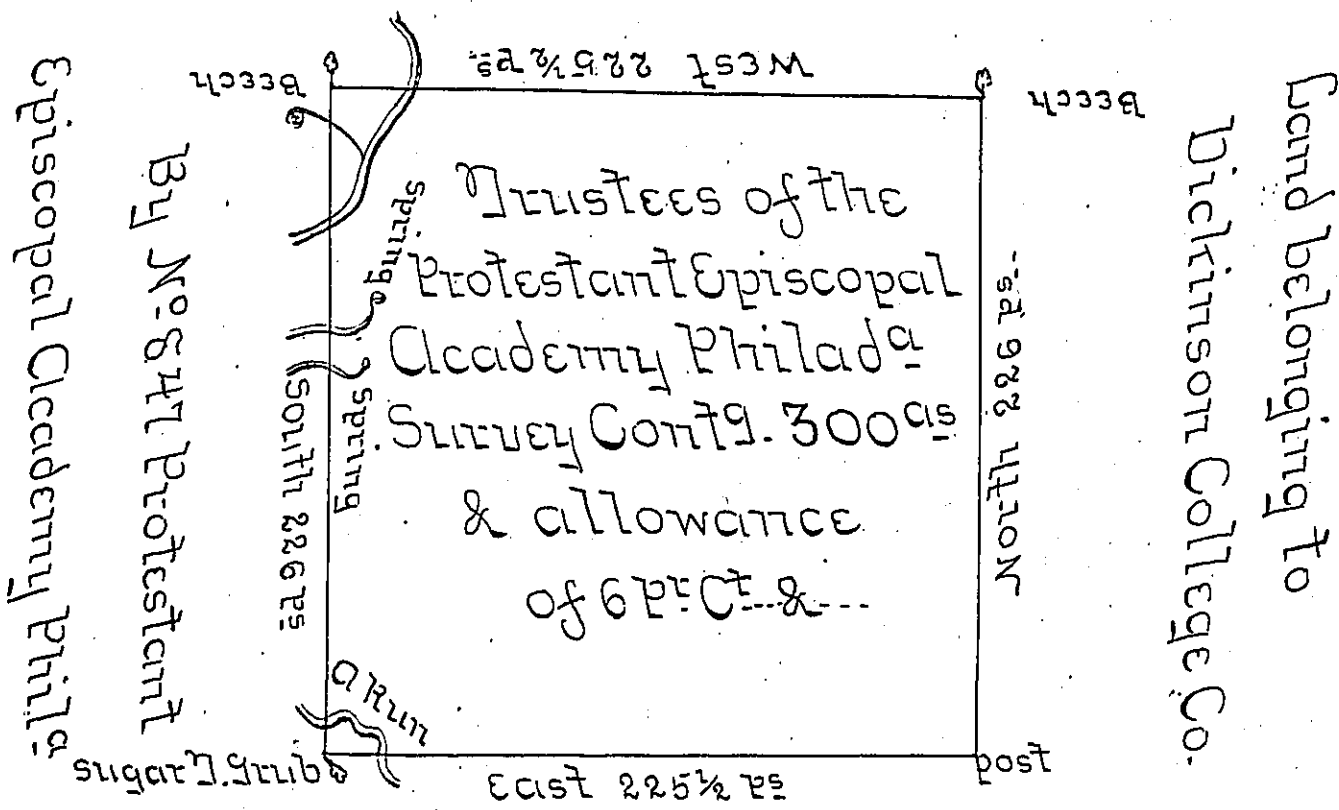


Adjacent Lands
