Witmer Co. Survey, on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1864 - It being a part of 339 acres and 91 perches with the usual allowance, as surveyed by Robert Evans, by authority from H.H. Curtz, then Co. Survey, in the year 1853, by Warrant granted to Frederick Fenstermaker, dated June 9<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1790, for 200 acres.
