



The Draft of a tract of land situate in Half moon township Center County containing four hundred and seventeen acres, eleven perches & Allowance of six per Cent & c. surveyed the 10th day of May 1820 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Henry Floyd dated the 15th day of March 1820.

The improvement on the above described tract of land consists of a Cabbing house and stable, and about ten or twelve acres of land cleared, Henry Floyd and family residing there on, first improved in the month of March 1809.
