



A Draught of a tract of Land situate in Dover township in the County of York containing as above set forth 287<sup>25</sup> & 61 perches and Allowance. Originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D. S. on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April 1753, in pursuance of two Warrants the One for 100<sup>25</sup> granted to Leonard Flower dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of April 1750. The other for 100<sup>25</sup> granted to George Schlegner bearing date the 24<sup>th</sup> day of September 1751, and afterwards to-wit: on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of December 1789 the same was Resurveyed by the old lines in pursuance of the same Warrants above described by John Forsyth late D. S. and now on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1818, at the request of the present owners George Beck and others the same has been calculated examined and found to be correct and at their request I am desired to make return of the Draught for confirmation
