



The above is a plot of a certain tract of land situate on the heads of a tributary of Toby's Creek, in Snyder township Jefferson County Penna surveyed on 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December 1856, in pursuance of Warrant dated Sept 8<sup>th</sup>-56. Beginning on District line at a sugar mile tree, thence South 60 rods to a fallen sugar thence by lands of Johnson & Hutchinson West four hundred and thirty four rods to a small Beech, thence North sixty rods to a Beech; thence by land of McCurly and others East four hundred and thirty four rods to the place of beginning. Containing 150<sup>95</sup> & 60<sup>25</sup>
