In pursuance of a warrant granted to Alexander Gled, Dated the 10th day of December, 1789, Re surveyed and corrected by the lines of the adjacent surveys. Made the 2^d 1806 and appears to contain Fifty four acres and 27 perches and the allowance of six feet for Roads.
