



Situate in Germany Township Adams County, being part of a larger tract surveyed June 20<sup>th</sup> 1766 by Arch<sup>d</sup>. McCleard D.S. by Warrant To Thomas Glazier dated 31<sup>st</sup> May 1762, and by said survey said to contain 134<sup>d</sup> 27<sup>ps</sup> & all, but now found to contain 105<sup>d</sup> 24<sup>ps</sup> & all. Surveyed & divided from the residue the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1809, containing 16<sup>d</sup> 91<sup>ps</sup> & all.
