Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 23rd day of August Ad. 1798. for George Gerverick, who bought the same from Peter Gerverick. And now at the request of the said George Gerverick. I am desired to make return of the draught as calculated and examined the 16th day of June Ad. 1809.


