Cent for Roads, being part of a larger Tract of one hundred and sixty four acres and three fourths of an acre & allowance of 6, Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Carmichael, bearing date the 19th June 1767. Re surveyed and laid off from the other parts of said Tract the 28th October, 1798, by Daniel Henderson Esq. formerly Deputy Surveyor, as appears by an Official Draught thereof remaining in my Office
