



A Draught of a Tract of Land containing One hundred and fifty five acres, besides the usual allowance of 6 p. Conty. Situate in Merctawamy in the County of Philadelphia, Duvied the 15<sup>th</sup> of November 1734. By virtue of a Warrt of the S<sup>th</sup> of March foregoing to William May, who not complying with the conditions thereof, the same became void, and the said tract was returned into the Secretary's Office the 1<sup>th</sup> of November 1742.
