



By Virtue of a warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 22^d of 8^{mo}. Anno Dom. 1737. The above described Tract of Land was surveyed unto James Swaffer in Robinson Township in the County of Lancaster, Beginning at a white oak. Thence North 65 degrees East by Vacant land 160 perches to a white oak. Thence North West by Vacant land 260 perches to a post. Thence South 65 degrees West by Vacant Land 86 perches to a white oak. Thence South 21 degrees East by Vacant Land 223 perches to a post. Thence South 80 degrees East by the land of John Treby Junior 38 perches to y^e place of Beginning, Containing Two Hundred acres beside y^e allowance of Six p Cent for Roads.
