



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries bearing date 16. 11. 1737. Surveyed by 23 of Feb. 1738 to James Harris a tract of land situated in the Township of Hannover in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a white oak thence North 10° East 180 ft. to a Spanish oak, thence North 80° East 156 ft. to a Black oak, thence South 11° East 140 ft. to a post, thence South 11° East 110 ft. to a Black Walnut standing by Suatarro Creekside, thence down the said Creek by its severall courses 226 ft. to the place of Beginning, containing two hundred and forty acres and the allowance of six p. Cent Surveyed by Edward Droul
