



A Draught of a Tract of Land situated in Antrim Township Franklin County, containing forty one acres and one hundred and fifty three perches and the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads, being part of a larger tract of sixty five acres and sixty eight perches and allowance &c, which was formerly surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Richard Gabel dated August 18<sup>th</sup> 1752, Resurveyed and laid off from the other part of the tract for George Decker, November 24<sup>th</sup> 1810.
