Being part of a larger tract of 319 Acres & Allowance Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. for William Smith, in pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>as</sup> granted to James Graham dated the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1747. The above part resurveyed & divided off the said larger tract for John Shultz at whose request the same is returned for confirmation. — August 13<sup>th</sup> 1821—
