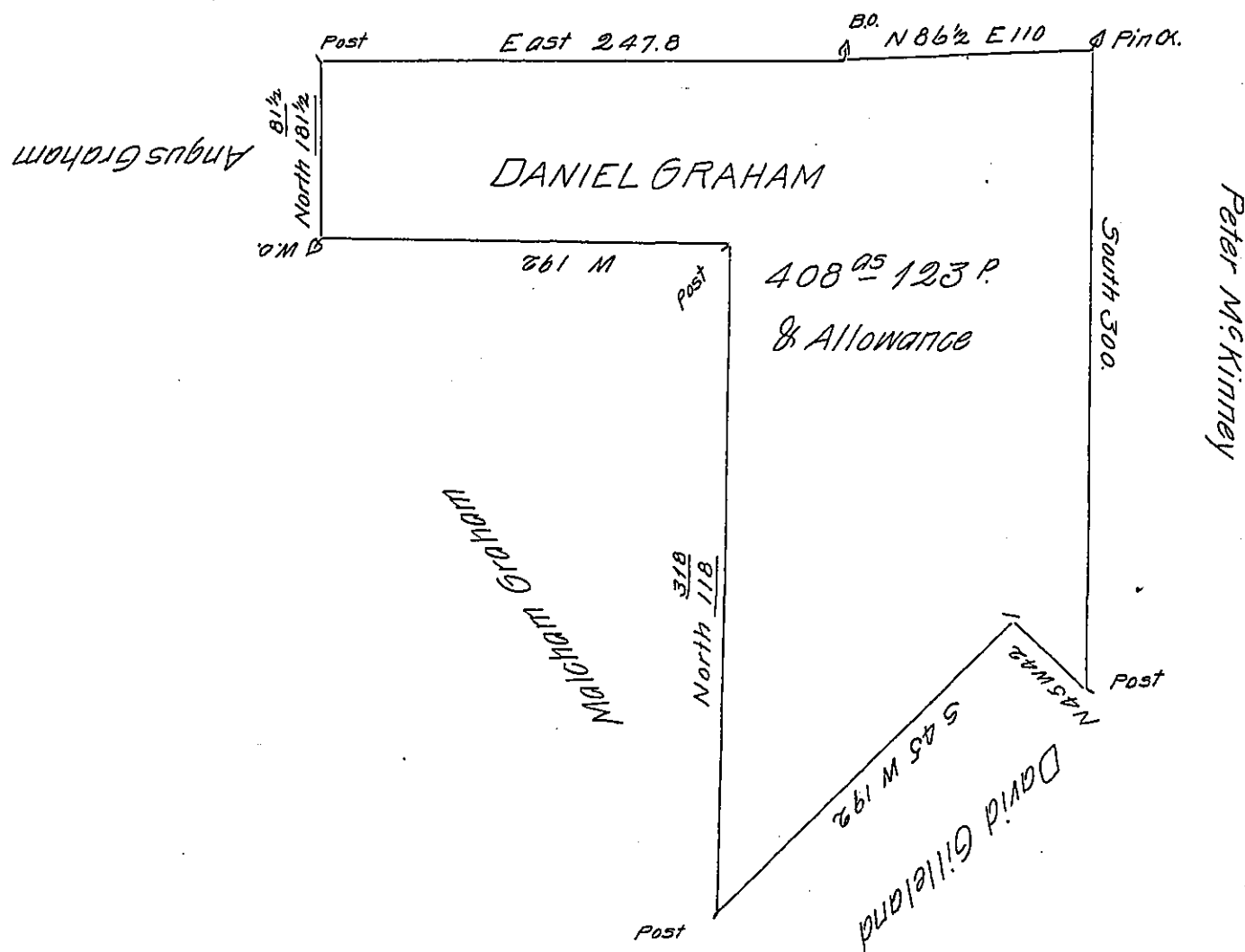


John Graham
