



Situate in Dover township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 18^{as} & 100 perches and allowance &c^a being part of a larger tract of 128^{as} & 91 perches &c^a of Land which was Originally Surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant for 100^{as} granted to David Grier bearing date the 18th day of February A.D. 1775. Resurveyed and Divided off from the said larger tract of Land the 10th of May 1811 for Tobias Frey at whose request the same is calculated, examined, corrected and returned for confirmation this 26th day of July A.D. 1827.
