



Draft of a tract of land situate in the Township of Greenwich in the County of Berks, containing One hundred and eleven acres, eighty nine perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed for John Deitrich junr. John Deitrich senr. Amendes Gehringer Jacob Arnold, Sarah Smith, and Noah Seip, the eighth day of February 1872 being part of a large tract of 203 acres 146 perches, and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Fauss dated the 7th day of December 1749.
