



In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres dated the twenty first day of April 1794. Granted to John Fisher was surveyed on the first day of July A.D. 1817 the above described tract of land containing 418 acres 93 perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. situate in Fairfield & part of Fallowfield Townships Crawford County and at the time of making the same Asher Williams Junier was residing thereon and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man and there appered to be upwards of ten acres of the Land cleared and fenced and in a state of cultivation.
