



In pursuance of two orders, viz: one special Order in the name of Cap<sup>l</sup> John Proctor dated April 1<sup>st</sup> 1769, N<sup>o</sup> 38, and one other Order in the name of Randle Mitchel dated April 3<sup>d</sup> 1769, N<sup>o</sup> 19. Surveyed to Col: John Proctor the above described tract of land containing three hundred and eighty five Acres and one hundred and twenty three perches with an allowance Proportioned to 6 p. Cent.

Situate on the twelve mile run and on the Great road leading from Ligonear to Fort Pitt; adjoining land of James Hunter, William Orier & others in Mount Pleasant Township Westmoreland County, Survey'd Nov<sup>r</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> 1784.
