



In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400, acres, Granted to William Harman bearing date the 21th day of ~~November~~ April 1794. was Resurveyed the 13th day of November, 1817 the above discribed tract of land containing 401<sup>a.</sup> 100 perches, and allowance of six percent for Roads &c. it being the same tract of land which was surveyed, the 7th day of November 1794 in Pursuance of Peter Paul, Improvement bearing date the 6th day of November 1794. Situate in sandy Creek Township Mercer County. Bounded North by Crawford County, and south by the south line of district N<sup>o</sup> 2, known by W<sup>m</sup> Power, district at the time of Executing the same there appeared to be cleared, fenced &c. upwards of ten acres of the land.
