



A Draught of a Tract of Land, Situate in Maccorigy Township in the County of Northampton, and State of Pennsylvania Containing Seventy Eight acres of Land, together with the usual allowance at six per Cent for Roads. That was surveyed to Christian Gorr (al. Curr.) By Virtue of a Warrant granted to him by the Honble Proprietaries dated on the 30th August Anno. — 1753. — Part of the same doth now belong to George Gorr Junior and the remainder to George Kibler, the son of Philip Kibler (al. Cooper) The same was formerly surveyed, and afterwards divided and now Resurveyed on the 21st October, Anno. — 1783.
