By virtue of a Warrant dated the 29th April 1811 Surveyed the 19th and 20th June 1820 to Adam Getz the above described tract of Land situate in Chesnut Hill township and Ross townships in Northampton County containing four hundred and sixty one acres a quarter and the allowance of six P. Cent &c Divided the same time between Adam Getz and Abraham Shafer
P. Geo. Palmer D.S.

N.B. It is the same tract that was returned to Andrew Ross by warrant of the 20th August 1793 for 431 acres & 53 perches Surveyed by Joseph Hemphill (which Survey I found Erroneous and I am told Adam Getz Recovered the Land by a decision of the Board of Property as part of it was improved
