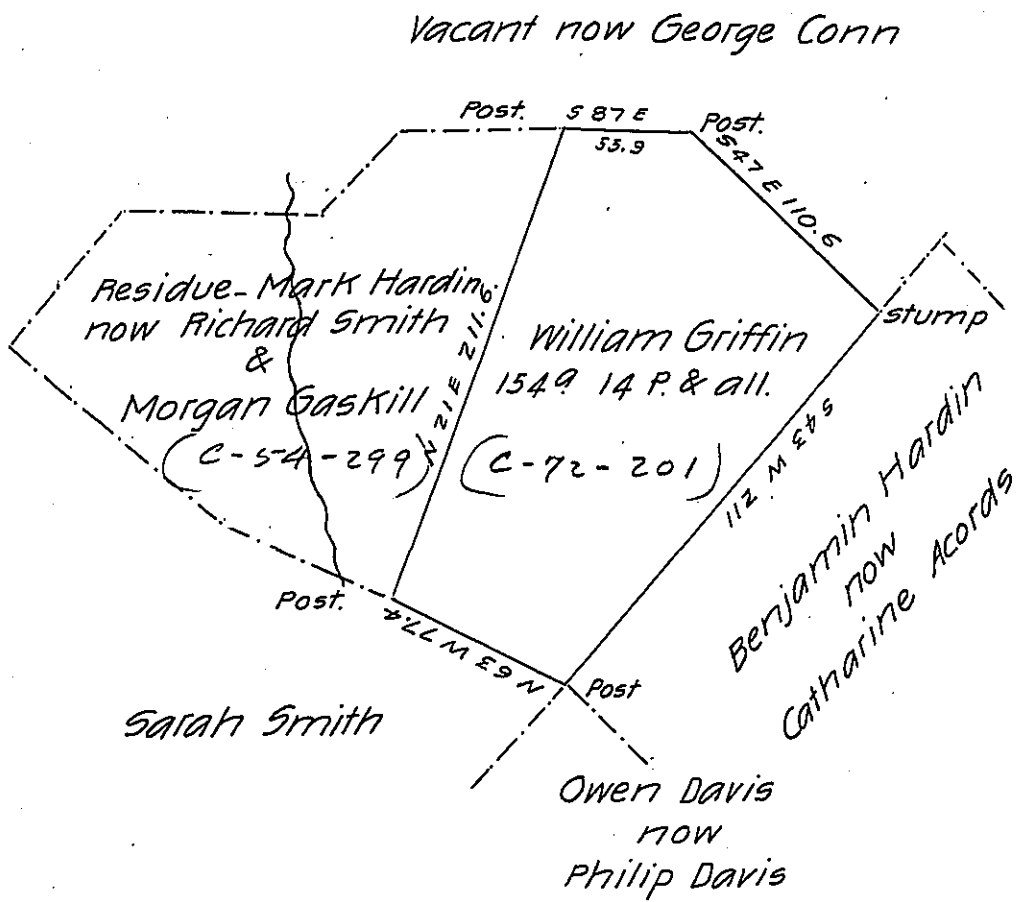

Situate on the waters of Georges creek in Springhill Township Fayette County & is part of a tract of land surveyed for Mark Hardin on the 18th day of April 1770 by order of survey No 3084 dated the 17th day of April 1769 since purchased and now owned by William Griffin the residue as represented is now owned by Richard Smith & Morgan Gaskill. — William Griffin desiring to Patent his part has requested a separate return thereof which I have caused to be made, the resurvey preparatory thereto was made the 5th Instant viz April 1824.
