Being part of a larger tract of 178 as. & allowance of Land which was Originally surveyed by Charles Lukens D.S. on the 25th day of April 1766 In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 29th day of June 1763 Granted to Toblrrence Glancey, Resurveyed obl divided off from the said larger tract of land on the 29th day of September 1812, for and at the request of the present owner Jacob Miller who desired that the same should be returned for Confirmation
