



A Draught of one hundred and forty eight acres and one hundred and thirty three perches of land with six per Cent for roads situate in Wayne Township in Mifflin (formerly Cumberland) County surveyed 17th August 1811 in pursuance of a warrant to James Galley dated 3^d June 1762.

Note, there is a great improvement on this land said to have been commenced upwards of sixty years ago and now in a high state of cultivation of a family residing on it.
