



By virtue of a Warrant, dated the 25th day of April A.D. 1853 and to me directed, I Surveyed the eight day of June 1851, for James Godfrey, the above described tract of land containing eight hundred & fifty six acres and forty two perches and Allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Situate on Tionesta Creek (in the last purchase made of the Indians) East of the Allegheny River and the Conewango Creek) in Tionesta Township, in Forest County Pa. and executed the Warrant, July 20th A.D. 1853.
