 in the Seventeen Townships in the County of Luzerne, and for other purposes there-
 in mentioned," passed the 4th day of April 1799 and the Supplement thereto passed
 the 15th day of March 1800, and the further Supplement thereto passed the 6th day
 of April 1802.
