Note The above draft represents a four Rod road layed out between
 the tiers of lots by the Commissioners duly appointed for putting in exe-
 cution an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania entitled
 "An Act for offering compensation to the Penna. Claimants of certain lands
 within the Seventeen townships in the County of Luzerne and for other
 purposes therein mentioned" passed the 4th day of April 1799 and the sup-
 plement thereto passed the 15th day of March 1800 and the further Supplement
 thereto passed the 6th day of April 1802. Henry Colt
