



Surveyed the above described trac of Land the 8 & 9 days of Feb 1837 for George Freeborn by Virtue of his Warrant for 350 acres in right of his improvement, Warrant dated 3rd Feb 1837 Situate on Rocky run, bounded by Lycoming Creek in Lewis Township Lycoming County & bounded as above described. Containing two hundred & fifteen acres & eighty nine ^{perches} with allowance &c. Note the improvements are about fifty acres of cleared land, with a log House & stable began in 1803. Note also that part of the above Survey Marked A. was returned to John Singer upon a resurvey of June 1808 upon an order of the Board of Property of Feb. 26th 1806 & the part Marked B. upon a survey to Aaron Levy of the same date.
