 & allow^o of 6 p^c for roads &c was Surveyed on the 6 June 1785
 To Jn^o Lukens Esq^r & Gen^l Signed by W^m Alexander D.S.
 Returned into the secret^s office for Matt^w Henderson the 19th Nov^r 1787
