



Situate in Franklin Township in the county of York the part A containing six acres ninety four perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c and the part B containing as above set forth forty one acres ninety four perches and allowance as aforesaid both being parts of a larger tract of 319 1/2 acres & allowance originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. for William Smith on the 16th day of May A.D. 1752 in pursuance of a Warrant for 100^{ac} granted to James Graham dated the 20th day of August 1747.

The above parts resurveyed and divided off for Conrad Frankberger the present owner of said parts at whose request the same are returned for confirmation January 2nd 1822.
