



Situate in Manahan Township in the County of York, (late part of Pensboro township in the county of Lancaster.) Containing as above set forth 13⁸⁵ & 85 perches and allowance &c being part of a larger tract of 319 1/2^{ac} & allowance &c which was originally surveyed on the 16th day of May 1752 for William Smith by George Stephanson late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 100^{ac} Granted to James Graham bearing date the 20th day of August 1747. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land on the 15th day of December 1814 and at the request of John Ernst one of the executors of Adam Ernst deceased the same is returned for confirmation
