



A Draught of a tract of land Situate in Berwick Township in the County of York ^{Re} surveyed the 12th day of November 1786 To Frederick Myer in pursuance of a warrant Granted to Abraham Hill dated the 8th day of June 1749 being part of an original survey made on said warrant by George Stevenson said to contain two hundred and sixty two acres & allowance.

The above resurvey made in pursuance of a warrant of resurvey dated the 17th day of April 1775 Myer's part contains one hundred and seventy five acres and two eights and allowance of six pct for roads & c.a.
