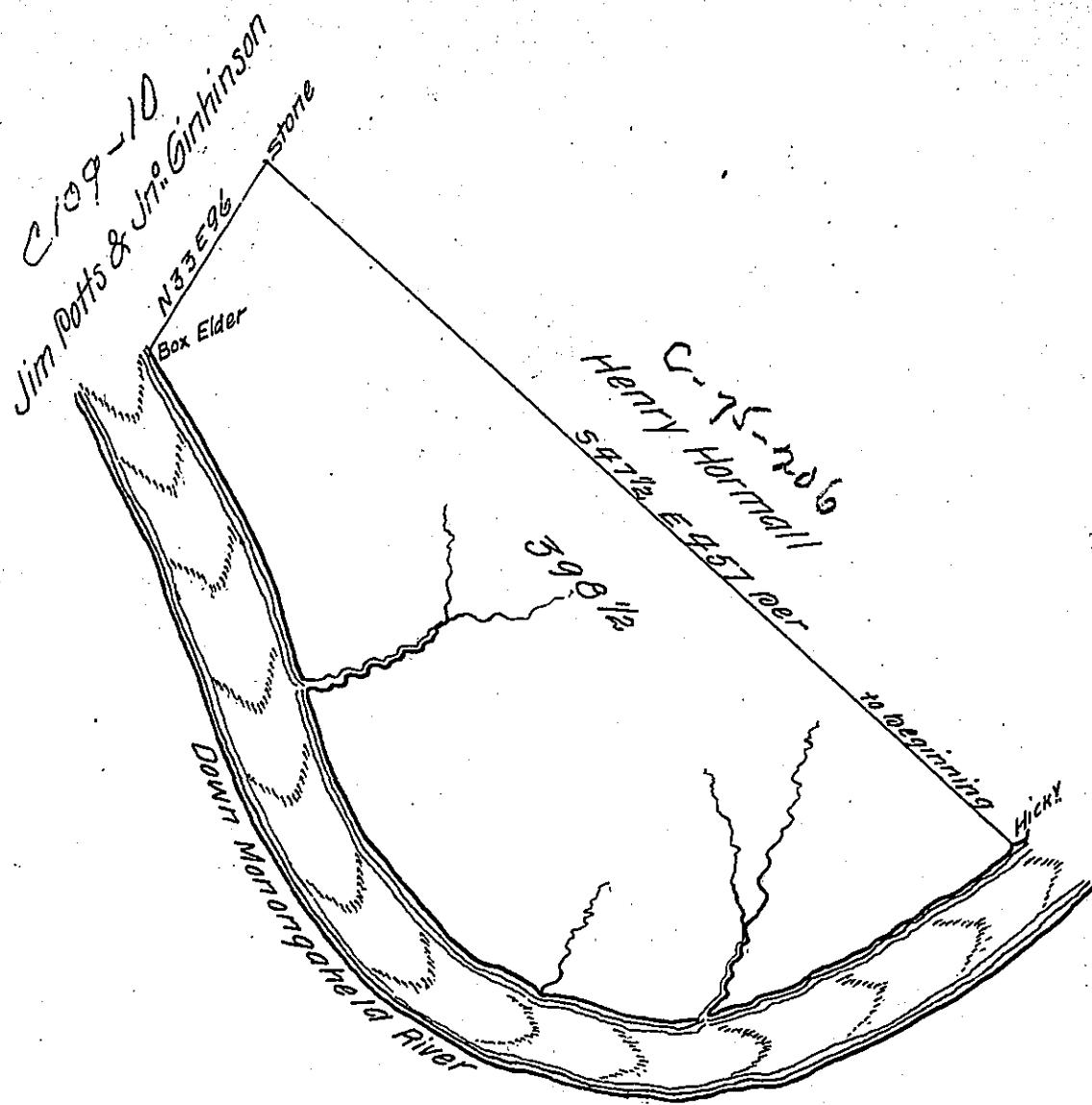

The above is a draught of a survey made June 1<sup>st</sup> 1786 in pursuance of a warrant granted John Harmall Feb<sup>y</sup> 16<sup>th</sup> 1786 call<sup>d</sup> Garland containing ~~598 1/2~~ acres together with six p<sup>er</sup> cent allowance for Roads &c.

The above was survey'd on a Virgin's certificate for s<sup>r</sup> Harmall which proves (upon examination) not good. you will therefore please to except this return in place of the one you have for s<sup>r</sup> Harmall which may be returned to me if thought prudent
