



A Draught of a Survey called the Siera Morena lying on Service C<sup>o</sup> in Washington County cont<sup>g</sup> 417 ac<sup>s</sup> 129 p<sup>s</sup> strict measure executed Feb<sup>y</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> 1780 in consequence of a certificate in these words  
 "We the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> for adjusting claims to unpatented lands in ye counties of Yohg<sup>a</sup> Monongahela & Ohio do hereby certify that Henry Allspaugh is entitled to four hundred ac<sup>s</sup> of Land in the County of Yohg<sup>a</sup> on the waters of Service C<sup>o</sup> to include his settlement made in ye year 1775.

Given under our hands at Coxs Fort ye 4<sup>th</sup> of Feb<sup>y</sup> 1780 in ye 4<sup>th</sup> year of ye Commonwealth
