



Situate on the North Fork of Georges Creek in George Township Fayette County and was Circumscribed by Moses M'Clean in 1770. But he having included more land than could consistant with his instructions be returned under a Location Right Struck off a part thereof and Jesse and Nathaniel Hunt having obtained a warrant for the over plus & the parties agreeing also to transfer their rights in such manner as the whole may devolve either to Jesse Hunt and Nathaniel Hunt or to Joseph Hunt who has purchased of John Griffy — I have Resurveyed the Land and marked it off agreeable to <sup>the</sup> purchase of said Joseph Hunt and also answerable to the description of Jesse and Nathaniel Hunt they wishing to include the whole in one patent The survey of John Griffy is by Location No 3070 dated 17<sup>th</sup> April 1769 and Jesse & Nathaniel Hunt by Warrant Dated the 22<sup>d</sup> Day of April 1788
