



A Draught of a tract of land Called - Situate on the Westerly side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna River on Hoopeney Creek adjoining and above land granted to George Tudor in the County of Northumberland and containing the quantity of two hundred and fifty six acres and seventy perches besides the usual allowance of six P cent for roads &c. Surveyed the thirtieth day of October 1775 for John Ladd Howell in pursuance of a Warrant dated the twenty first day of March 1775.
