



Surveyed on the Thirteenth day of July 1733. To Rudolph Hatchler a certain Tract of land Situate in Oley in the County of Palmd. Beginning at a Hickery sapling in the line of Hans Sniders land thence by Vacant Land South West one hundred and ninety perches to a post in the line of Peter Furnevall's Land thence by the same North West thirty seven perches to the s. Furnevall's Corner being a post, thence the same course by Vacant land one hundred eighty seven perches to a post, thence by Vacant land North East one hundred and ninety perches to a Hickery sapling thence by Vacant sixteen perches to a corner post of the aforesaid Hans Sniders land thence by the said Sniders land South East two hundred twenty four perches to the place of Beginning. Containing Two hundred and fifty acres, with usual allowance
