



The plan of a Lot of ground situate on the South side of High Street and East side of Duke Street in the Town of York No. 28 containing in Breadth on High Street sixty five feet & in length on Duke Street to a twenty feet alley two hundred & thirty feet, bounded Northward with High Street, Eastward with a Lot of ground No. 27, Southward with a twenty feet alley and westward with Duke Street, entered on the plan of the said Town and Survey'd for Barnhart Holzinger who has built a house on the same according to the Conditions of settling the Town, Certified at York the 1st June 1753.
