



A Plan of a Lot of Ground Situate on the West side of Beaver Street in the Town of York, marked on the General Plan of the said Town Number one hundred and eleven, containing in Breadth on the said Street fifty seven feet and six inches and in length to a Twenty foot Alley two hundred and fifty feet. Bounded eastward with Beaver Street aforesaid, Southward with a Lot of Ground, marked on the plan of s<sup>d</sup>. Number one hundred and twelve, Westward with a twenty-foot Alley and Northward with a Lot of Ground marked on the said plan Number One hundred and ten, formerly surveyed & laid out to Jacob Hose, who has built a house thereon according to the Conditions of settling the s<sup>d</sup>. Town, Certified at York, the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1763
