



By Virtue of a Warrant bearing date the 30th of Sept. 1760 I have
 on the 16th of October 1760
 Surveyed unto Thomas Houghton of the City of Philad^a, Cooper, a certain Lot
 of Ground. Situated in the said City on the Bank of Delaware River
 between Mulberry Street and Sassafras Street. Being part of a
 Bank and Water Lot, formerly granted to Thomas Holmes, Con-
 taining in Breadth Twenty feet and in depth forty five feet, Bounded
 westward with Delaware Front Street, Northward with ground of
 Jarvis Bywater, Eastward with Delaware Street and Southward
 with ground now in the tenure of Margaret Clymer, Widow.
