Survey'd the above described Water Lot unto Richard Hockley, being the Northern Moiety of a Water Lot formerly Survey'd (as it is said) to William Dalaway, situate in the City of Philad^a, between Pine Street & Cedar Street & between Penn Street & the River Delaware, contⁿ in Breadth on the s^e Penn Street & the s^e River 51 feet & in length 250 feet. Bounded Northw^d with the ground late of John Soben, now of Thomas Willing Eastw^d with the River Delaware, Southw^d with the Southernmost Moiety of the above Lot, said to be survey'd to William Dalaway, & Westw^d with Penn Street.
