



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June, 1872, a survey was made on the 3^d of July following, of a certain lot of ground in the Town of Dunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Seventy four, containing in breadth North and South fifty seven feet and six inches, and in length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet, bounded Westward by Broad Way, Southward by Lot No. 45, Eastward by River Alley, and Northward by Lot No. 43, as by the General Plan of said Town, remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear, Returned into the Secretary's Office the 9th day of June 1873
