



The above draught represents an Island in Big Beaver River, a branch of the Ohio River, Surveyed December 4th 1837, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Benjamin Chew, dated May 13th 1837 situate in or near the Falls or Rapid called the Irish Ripple in North Sewickley Township Beaver County Pa. Containing 5 acres 63 perches and allowance of six per cent.
