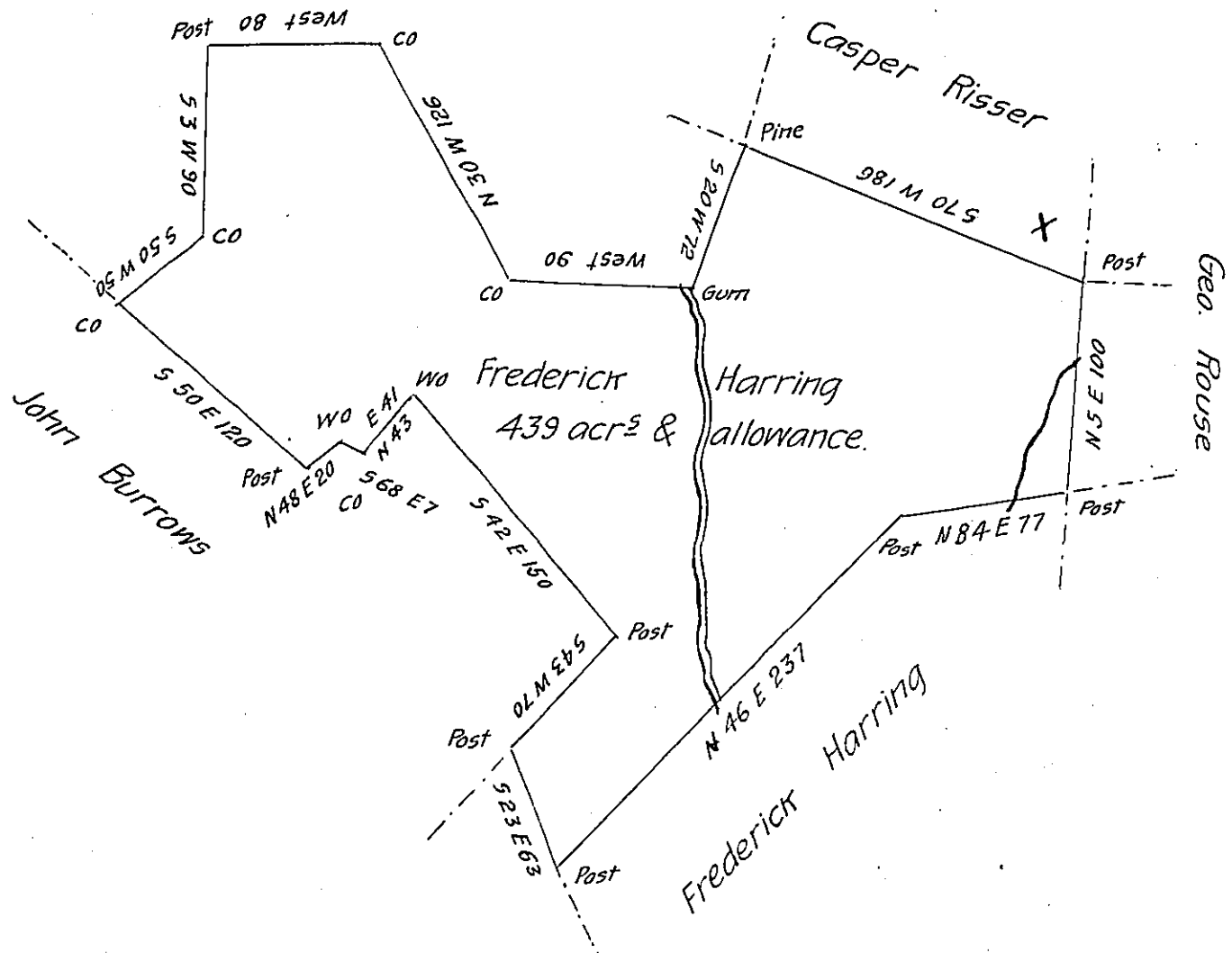


John Bever

 these remarks and due submisson. Containing Four Hundred &
 thirty nine acres and allowance of Six pr Cent &c
